IMPACTING LIVES



In April of 2023, the Missouri Department of Corrections partnered with Transformation Ozarks to focus on and instill transformative values to the people they serve through Transformation Tables.

This is John. John recently wrapped up his first experience with a Transformation Table in August, and through this table, experienced a shift in his life that would change him forever.

John's final table lesson was on forgiveness. Digging into things like: what is true forgiveness, how do I live a life with no "unfinished business," why is forgiveness important, how do I even start to forgive. After learning about this value, he got to a section of the table where you assess and reflect on how well you do with the value and then identify what are areas that you can grow in and share it to the rest of the group for accountability. This is what he shared:

"In 2016, I lost my son to a domestic violence incident. My son's mother's boyfriend murdered my son at 3.5 yrs old. As someone who struggled with addiction, this sent me spiraling deeper into my addiction and behaviors that led to trouble. I have since found Jesus and given my life to Him, but for the longest time, I struggled with unforgiveness. I have never been able to forgive the man that killed my son. Tonight, I also realized that I have never been able to forgive myself for allowing my son to be in that position. But I now have the know how to do this...and this starts tonight." - John
